



CONNECT WITH YOUR SPONSORED CHILD THROUGH WRITING LETTERS!

We are thrilled that you are thinking of writing your sponsored child! Whether it's for the first time or to send them an extra note of encouragement, we want to help you foster a relationship with your child through your letters. Here are some guidelines to follow when writing your child so they can easily understand and reply to your letter.

Your child will receive your letters in person when we send teams to Uganda. We will be sure to make you aware when we have trips scheduled so you can make sure you have written to your child.

HERE ARE SOME HELPFUL TIPS WHEN WRITING YOUR LETTER:

English is your child's second language. Keep your letter short (no more than a half a page), and to write in simple sentences.

Write as if you're writing to a kindergartener so it's easy for them understand what you're saying.

Tell them about yourself and your family. They will want to know about **YOU!**

It's important to be culturally conscientious. Please be sensitive to talking about your possessions, such as cars, vacations, etc.

Ask them about their interests, what they enjoy studying, and what they want to be when they grow up!

Finally, let them know you are praying for them and that you care about them.
